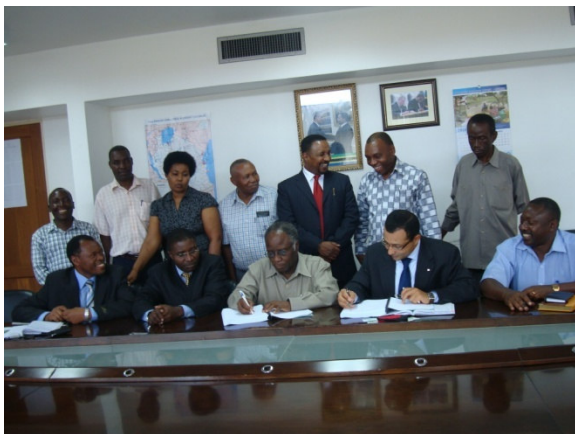
**MCA –T SIGNS CONSULTANCY SERVICES CONTRACT WITH SNC LAVALIN INTERNATIONAL S.A.S FOR MAFIA ISLAND AIRPORT PROJECT**

Millennium Challenge Account-Tanzania (MCA-T) has signed consultancy services contract with M/s **SNC LAVALIN INTERNATIONAL S.A.S** worth US\$ 1.5 million for design, review and construction supervision for upgrading of Mafia Island Airport.

During the official signing ceremony which was held on 7<sup>th</sup> October 2010 at the MCA-T Office in Dar es Salaam, MCA-T CEO Mr. Bernard S. Mchomvu said “I congratulate you for winning the tender and it is our expectations that you will start immediately”

The signing ceremony was also attended by Acting Director General of Tanzania Airports Authority (TAA) Eng. Suleiman S. Suleiman and Senior Staff from TAA and MCA-T.

This component is part of the Transportation Sector projects under the five years Compact grant, extended to the United Republic of Tanzania by the Millennium Challenge Corporation of the United States of America, with the objective to reduce poverty and stimulate economic growth. The project will enhance transportation network between Mafia and other destinations for social and economic purposes.
