The Engineer shall oversee the works during the Defects Notification Period. Prior to commencement of the Defects Notification Period, the Engineer shall deliver a Taking-Over Certificate. For the purpose of carrying out the services, the consultant shall assign one key person to have quarterly site visits to monitor the rectifications on unattended/uncompleted activities, prepare and issue the Final Payment Certificate. During this period the consultant shall be required to draw the attention of the contractor to any defects if and when noticed and shall supervise such remedial works. The Consultant will be required to issue Quarterly Reports in the Defects Liability Period. The distribution of the reports will be as follows: Six (6) copies to the Employer's Representative HQ, Four (4) copies to the Employer, and one (1) copy to the Roads Division, Pemba.
