Millennium Challenge Account-Tanzania (MCA-T) has signed a contract with M/s UWP Consulting for supervision services on Expansion of the Lower Ruvu Water Treatment Plant. The contract will be for 24 months.

During the official signing ceremony which was held on 2nd December 2010 at the MCA-T Office in Dar es Salaam, MCA-T CEO Mr. Bernard S. Mchomvu said

Expansion of Lower Ruvu Water Treatment Plant is part of the Water Sector projects under the five years Compact grant, extended to the United Republic of Tanzania by the Millennium Challenge Corporation of the United States of America, with the objective to reduce poverty and stimulate economic growth. The Plant will be expanded from current production of 180 to 270 million liters per day project will enhance efficient supply of water for domestic and industrial purposes for residents in Dar es Salaam and Coast Regions
