**CHINESE COMPANY SIGNS WORKS CONTRACT WITH MCA-T TO IMPROVE WATER SUPPLY
SYSTEM OF MOROGORO MUNICIPALITY**

On 15th day of December 2010, MCA-T signed works contract with **Zhonghao Overseas Construction Engineering Company Limited of China** worth 8,316,144.10USD to carry out works of Rehabilitation and Expansion of the Water Supply system of Morogoro Municipality from current production of 22 to 33 million litres per day. The duration of the works according to engineering estimates will be 24 months.

During the official signing ceremony which was held at the MCA-T Office in Dar es Salaam, MCA-T CEO Mr. Bernard S. Mchomvu said
